

PREDATOR SPEED SKATE CLUB CONSTITUTION & BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I

NAME:

1. The club hereinafter constituted shall be known as the Predator Speed Skate Club™. The Name and Logo of the Predator Speed Skate Club is Trade Marked for the sole purpose of promoting the sport of inline speed skating in the state of Arizona.

ARTICLE II

OBJECTIVES:

1. To advance and improve the sport of inline speed skating.

ARTICLE III

MEMBERSHIP:

1. Membership in the Club shall be open to all qualified individuals regardless of race, color, creed, sex, or age.
2. A club member is identified as “A qualified skater of the club who meets the following”:
 - a. Must hold a Predator membership card.
 - b. Membership yearly dues paid.
 - c. Must possess an ANSI/ SNELL approved helmet
 - d. Must meet all other membership requirements, i.e. signed waiver, membership form...
 - e. All members will be required to pay the weekly practice fees to participate at the Castle-n-Coasters parking lot as approved by the Executive Board.

ARTICLE IV

NEW MEMBERS:

1. A skater becomes eligible if he or she can skate well forward for the age category of which he or she will represent. (Novice’ beginners should seek outside instruction before applying for membership)
2. The Executive Board must approve all new members before membership is given.
3. All new members will be required to pay the yearly dues before receiving any club benefits.
4. Additional family members will be given the appropriate discount for family membership.
5. Each new member must agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the club.

ARTICLE V

VIOLATIONS:

1. Any member who violates any of the provisions of the Constitution, by-laws, or Rules of this Club and / or refuses to abide by any decision of the Officers or Executive Board of the Club, and / or refuses to recognize any suspensions or expulsions of the Club, and / or whose conduct is subversive or detrimental to the best interest of the Club may be suspended or expelled by a majority vote of the Executive Board of the Club.
2. Any member who becomes delinquent over 30 days in paying Club yearly or practice fees or who fails to meet any other financial obligation to the Club shall be suspended from the Club until fees are paid in full, at which time will be reinstated with the approval of the Executive Board.
3. Any member expelled from the Club will not be reinstated under any circumstances except by a unanimous vote of the Executive Board.

ARTICLE VI

GOVERNING BODY:

1. The Power of government of this Club shall be vested in an Executive Board. The Board will consist of a President, Vice President and Secretary.

BY-LAWS
ARTICLE I

DUTIES & POWERS OF THE OFFICERS:

1. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Club and shall exercise usual duties pertaining to the office of President.
2. The Vice-President shall have all the powers and perform all duties of the President during the absence of the President. Vice-President will act as the Treasurer and shall keep the accounts and financial records of the Club, receive all monies, pay all bills and shall make an itemized statement of the financial condition of the Club whenever called upon by the President to do so.
3. The Secretary shall keep a record of the minutes of all meetings.
4. The Executive Board has the right to waive the requirements of any Article of the Constitution, by-laws, or any of the Rules and Regulations of the Club for extenuating circumstances.
5. The Executive Board shall receive and act on all written complaints from members.
6. The Executive Board shall enforce the Constitution, the by-laws, and the Rules and Regulations of the Club.

ARTICLE II

MEMBERS TERM OF OFFICE:

1. The term of office for the Club Representative to the Executive Board, i.e. President, Vice-President, and Secretary shall be Two years or may continue by a majority vote of the Club members at the end of the fiscal year.

ARTICLE III

AMENDMENTS:

1. This Constitution can be amended only by a two-thirds vote of the entire membership.
2. Proposed changes must be announced during Club sessions with a minimum of 14 days in advance prior to a vote.

ARTICLE IV

DISSOLUTION OF THE CLUB:

1. In the event the Club shall become dissolved, all monies on hand or collectable, after all financial obligations of the Club have been met, shall be equally distributed among the members in good standing.
2. By a two-thirds majority vote of the members in good standing, distribution of the remaining assets may be made in a different manner.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All skaters in good standing may practice ONLY at the said time and days allocated by Castles-n-Coasters Inc. (Tuesday/ Thursday 7-9pm)
2. Every skater must wear an ANSI/ SNELL approved helmet at all times while wearing skates.
3. Members of the Predator Speed Skate Club must present proper skating etiquette and representation of the Club at all competitions or be subject to suspension by the Board.
4. All skaters are responsible for their own equipment at all times.
5. Any member of the Club may seek outside sponsorship to further their skating career as long as it does not conflict with any current Club sponsors agreements. (Must be approved by the Board).
6. Any member bringing a guest assumes responsibility for that guest while on the premises of Castle-n-Coasters property.
7. Use of the Name and Logo of the Predator Speed Skate Club is limited to the Executive Board or approved by the executive Board.
8. Predator Phone, Address or email list's are for member use only. Member information shall never be given out without the specific member's permission.
9. All club members must show club membership cards for discount purchases from Ski Pro/ Ski Chalet.
